Federal Work-Study Program (FWS)

WHAT IT IS ...

- The award represents an amount of money set aside for you to earn by working at a job either on campus or at a nonprofit agency off campus.
- You earn your award by working in a department on campus or in a community organization. Many students work in jobs related to their CCM majors.

Earnings

- Students working on campus may earn minimum wage or higher, depending on their positions, working no more than 19.5 hours per week during the semester and up to 24.5 hours per week during school breaks.
- Once hired, you will turn in a timesheet every two weeks and receive a paycheck two weeks later, to spend on whatever you need.
- Students working off campus earn varying amounts as determined by the employing organization.

WHAT IT IS NOT . . .

- This award cannot be applied to your tuition bill.
- You are not guaranteed a job but you do get first priority in the hiring.
- Accepting work-study will not decrease your grant aid.
- Declining work-study will not increase your grant aid.
