CCM'S CHALLENGER PROGRAM

The **Challenger Program** allows high school students to enrich their education through college-level coursework directly at County College of Morris (CCM).

Many refer to this option as an accelerated college program. Students are given the opportunity to earn college credits in areas such as art, social sciences, technology, languages, music and more, along with earning their general education requirements in English, math and science.





STEP 1

COMPLETE THE ONLINE APPLICATION

Visit www.ccm.edu/admissions/ to fill out our online application and pay the \$30 application fee. When you are choosing your academic program, be sure to select “Challenger Program- Non-Matric.”

STEP 2

MEET WITH YOUR ADVISOR

You will be assigned an Academic Advisor to assist you with course selection and registration.

Remedial/developmental English, mathematics and ESL classes cannot be taken as a Challenger Student.

Placement into college level English and math courses will be determined through placement testing.

Students meeting minimum required scores on the SAT, ACT or NJSLA standardized tests may be eligible for exemption from placement testing.

STEP 3

REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Register for courses online through your Titans Direct account.

Submit tuition payment through your Titans Direct account.
